TALLER MAIBOCK

STRONG. ROUGH. BAVARIAN

Taller Maibock is a variety of a strong lager "bock" which first saw the light in the 13th century in German monasteries. Traditionally, bocks were brewed in December – January, when the sun was in the zodiacal constellation of Capricorn or Goat that gave the name to this beer. Also "bock" is a goat in German. That's why this beer often has goats on the labels.

Maibock (May bock) is a stronger alcohol version of the bock. As a rule, it was brewed in spring for May holidays.

Taller Maibock is a dark amber strong beer with rich barley taste, well expressed hoppy bitterness and fruit notes.

Ingredients: water, light barley malt, barley or corn grist, hops

Packaging: glass bottle 0.5L



Chernigivske «Bile» -

unfiltered beer, which is brewed by traditional brewing technology with one specialty - it doesn't pass the filtering process that allows to keep small pieces of barley and hops in the beer. Due to this Chernigivske "Bile" has a unique white color and natural taste.

Ingredients: water, pale barley malt, wheat, light wheat malt, barm, coriander, stabilizer apple pectin, hops.

Alcohol: not less than 4.8% vol.

Packaging: glass bottle 0.5l, can 0.5l, PET bottle 1l, PET bottle 1.5l, keg 30l, keg 50l.
